- 3. Students admitted in these courses prior to the academic year 2021-22 shall continue to be the students of MGMCH till they pass out these courses.
- 4. Teaching of the students of these courses, whether admitted in MGMCH or in MGIAHS shall be conducted at one place i.e. at MGIAHS.
- 5. To recommend for starting of MSc Nuclear Medicine Technology program with intake capacity of 30 seats per year.

Agenda No. 3

To consider revision of syllabuses of Para Medical, Medical Technology and Allied Health Sciences courses.

The Committee deliberated upon the course contents and scheme of examination of undergraduate courses of Para Medical, Medical Technology and Allied Health Sciences. It was realized that there is a need of updations of these syllabuses. Further the Committee noted that there is no provision of internship in the syllabuses of these courses, whereas internship is must to make these programs complete. In the absence of internship, the students will not be eligible for suitable jobs and higher studies in respective areas.

The Committee reviewed all the syllabuses of undergraduate and postgraduate Para Medical, Medical Technology and Allied Health Sciences courses:

- 1. Syllabuses of postgraduate Para Medical, Medical Technology and Allied Health Sciences courses were updated (Annexure-2)
- 2. Syllabuses of undergraduate Para Medical, Medical Technology and Allied Health Sciences courses were reviewed and updated with a provision of one year internship after successful completion of three years course (Annexure-2)
  - Members thoroughly discussed about scheme of theory and practical examination marks and concluded that both theory and practical be given equal importance with equal total marks. To make it more clear, if the total of theory paper examination marks is 400 then total of practical examination marks shall also be 400. University examination shall carry 70% marks and internal assessment shall carry 30% marks in theory as well as practical examination.
- 3. It has been decided to add Electives Course (Non-University Examination) in the syllabuses of M.Sc. and B.Sc. Programs from academic year 2022-23 (Annexure-3).
- 4. One year internship after completion of three years course shall be compulsory for the students admitted in the academic year 2019-20 and afterwards.



- 5. Degrees shall be awarded only to such students who complete one year internship after passing undergraduate Para Medical, Medical Technology and Allied Health Sciences courses.
- 6. Names of the students who are eligible for the award of degrees after successfully completing one year internship shall be conveyed by the Director, MGIAHS to the University. These names shall be submitted by the respective Dean to the Academic Council for passing grace for the award of the degrees.
- 7. Students who have already passed undergraduate Para Medical, Medical Technology and Allied Health Sciences courses from MGMCH shall not be allowed for one year internship.

A joint meeting of Faculty of Medicine & Surgery and Board of Studies in (Clinical, Non- Clinical & Para-Clinical) subjects under Faculty of Medicine & Surgery, MGUMST was held on April 12, 2022 at 2:30 P.M. in the Conference Room of the MG Medical College under the Chairmanship of Dr Swati Garg, Dean, Faculty of Medicine & Surgery.

The Dean, Faculty of Medicine & Surgery Chairing the meeting accorded a cordial welcome to all the members attending the meeting. The agenda was then discussed and following recommendations were made—

1. To review the Syllabus of MSc (Medical) Programs (Anatomy, Physiology, Microbiology, Biochemistry and Pharmacology).

The Dean, Faculty of Medicine & Surgery informed that the Committee constituted vide Office Order No. MGUMST/ACAD/Committee/2022/23 dated 19-01-2022 by the President, MGUMST to review the Syllabus (course of study and scheme of examination) of MSc (Medical) Programs (Anatomy, Physiology, Microbiology, Biochemistry and Pharmacology) including model questions papers has submitted revised syllabus of MSc (Medical) Programs for consideration and approval.

The members of Faculty of Medicine & Surgery and BOS under Faculty of Medicine & Surgery deliberated upon these syllabuses and resolved to recommend that the updated syllabuses (course of study and scheme of examination) of MSc (Medical) Programs (Anatomy, Physiology, Microbiology, Biochemistry and Pharmacology) be made effective from academic year 2022-23 and onwards.

2. To consider updated Syllabus of MBBS program.

The Conveners of the Board of Studies (BOS) in Clinical, Non- Clinical and Para-Clinical subjects under Faculty of Medicine & Surgery informed that the syllabus (containing course of study, scheme of examination and Model papers) of MBBS program has been updated by the Head of the Department of the concerned subject, in consultation with the faculty members

After due deliberations, it was resolved to approve the updated syllabus of MBBS program.

3. To consider implementation of new Competency based Medical Education (CBME) for UG Course Curriculum.

It was informed that as per National Medical Commission (NMC) circular no. U.11026/1/2022-UGMEB dated 31-03-2022, the NMC has issued guidelines



for implementation of new CBME course curriculum for MBBS batch 2021-22 admitted in Feb-March 2022 (Annexure-III).

The matter was discussed and deliberated in detail and resolved that Dean & Principal, MGMC&H shall take immediate necessary steps to implement new CBME course curriculum for MBBS batch 2021-22 admitted in Feb-March 2022 in compliance of above mentioned NMC circular.

 Amalgamation of old and new batch of MBBS students in the new CBME course curriculum.

It was informed that as per National Medical Commission (NMC) circular no. U.11026/1/2022-UGMEB dated 31-03-2022, the NMC has decided that the old and new batch of MBBS students should be amalgamated in the new CBME Course Curriculum for MBBS students from the current academic session i.e. 2021-22 with the objective of covering all three domains of learning (Cognitive, affective & Psychomotor), subject to informed written consent of the students. The new course curriculum introduced in August 2019 enriches the medical student with a sound base and balanced approach to overall aspect with the introduction of foundation course which includes Family Adoption Programme, Yoga, meditation, Local Language adaptation and skills. The curriculum committee of the erstwhile MCI has aligned and integrated the basic knowledge of pre and Para Clinical Subject with the clinical Subjects. Earlier clinical exposure, AETCOM module, Problem based learning, Domain wise education and exposure, developing interest in basic research is likely to bring a positive impact and enhancement in job opportunities to these young graduates.

The aforementioned matter was discussed and deliberated in detail and resolved that Dean & Principal, MGMC&H shall take necessary actions to complete the required formalities with regard to amalgamation of old and new batch of MBBS students in the new CBME Course Curriculum on priority.



The Faculty resolved to accept the submission of the Convener, BOS in Super Specialty and further decided that similar action be taken by the Conveners of other Boards of Studies with respect to the subjects assigned to their Boards.
- 7. The Faculty considered the matter of timely conduction of the examinations of final MBBS Part-I & Part-II so that further schedule of the pass out candidates of these examination may not be delayed. The Faculty therefore resolved that the Dean & Principal, MGMC&H may submit his proposal in this regard to the Controller of Examinations who would implement it after seeking approval of the President.

### Graduate Medical Education Regulation (GMER) 2019

The Graduate Medical Education Regulation (GMER) 2019 have come into force from the 6 November 2019. The UG curriculum has undergone a revolutionary change in the manner of the syllabus, the duration and the working hours scheduled for the students admitted in the medical college since batch 2019.

The following points were discussed and put forth for the smooth implementation of the new curriculum.

Duration of the course: 4and half years to be implemented as mentioned in the GMER.

Time distribution of the MBBS programme is given in Table 1.of the GMER 2019 page 67. The changes shown is the duration of each professional.

- 1<sup>st</sup> MBBS: 14 months (1+12+1)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> MBBS: 12 months (11+1)
- 3<sup>rd</sup> MBBS part 1: (13 months (12+1)
- Incorporation of 2 months of electives between the 3<sup>rd</sup> MBBS Part 1 and 3<sup>rd</sup> MBBS Part 2
- 3<sup>rd</sup> MBBS part 2: 13 months (12 +1)
- Subjects like
- Community medicine to be covered in phase 1, 2and 3
- Forensic medicine and toxicology in phases 2 and 3
- Clinical subjects to be started in 2<sup>nd</sup> MBBS till 3<sup>rd</sup> part 2...
- Time table has to be uploaded for all phases in the desired format. i,e instead of mentioning only the topic in the given subject slot, it will mention the competency along with the name of the faculty. A full year academic calendar has to be uploaded before the commencement of the academic year. Time table will be in accordance with the hours prescribed. phase 1 has already done.
- 3. Implementation of the new curriculum in phase 1
  - 1. Foundation course (1 month)
  - 2. Early Clinical Exposure
  - 3. Sports activities
  - 4. Self directed learning
  - AETCOM (phase 1,2,3 and 4)
- 4. Special emphasis for vertical and horizontal integration in all phases.
- 5. Maintenance of the logbook is a must for all the students. These will be uploaded in the student's institutional ID every six month. The logbook uploading will be through the P/C office. Subject teachers will make a list of competencies to be certified, the students have to achieve the competency and get certified from the concerned teacher.
- University will come up with a calendar which will have schedule of the vacation for the students, university holidays which will make the task of making the time table easier.
- The calendar will also have an academic calendar which will give a schedule dates for the internal assessment and university examination.
- Internal assessments: Three in preclinical /para clinical
   Two in clinical subjects

- 9 Assessment of the students to be done in each phase if subject is taught in more than one phase, result to be compiled at the end. The results of internal assessment should be displayed on the notice board within a 1-2 weeks
- 10 The internal assessment forms the eligibility criteria for taking the university examination. Internal assessment will reflect as a separate head of passing in the summative examination.
- 11 University examination pattern:
  - a. The viva voce /Grand viva marks to be added in the practical marks (100marks)
  - The theory papers two ( for majority of the subjects) will have
    - 1. Objective type -20 % of the total marks for each paper
    - 2. Structured short notes
    - 3. Structured long question.
  - c. the maximum marks for each paper 100 marks
  - d. the question paper will have three sections
     Section A -MCQ 20 MCQ 1 mark each 20 marks)
     Section B short notes and Long Answer questions (40 marks)
     Section C- short notes and Long Answer questions (40 marks)

#### 12 Examiners: ,

For an intake of 100 learners (2 external and 2 internal examiners). Of the four examiners, the senior-most internal examiner will act as the Chairman and coordinator of the whole examination programme so that uniformity in the matter of assessment of candidate is maintained. Where candidates appearing are more than 100, two additional examiners (one external & one internal) for every additional 50 or part there of candidate appearing, be appointed.

#### 13 Attempts

- a) No more than four attempts shall be allowed for a candidate to pass the first Professional examination. The total period for successful completion of first Professional course shall not exceed four (4) years. Partial attendance of examination in any subject shall be counted as an attempt.
- A learner, who fails in the second Professional examination, shall not be allowed to appear in third Professional Part I examination unless she/he passes all subjects of second Professional examination.
- c) Passing in third Professional (Part I) examination is not compulsory before starting part II training; however, passing of third Professional (Part I) is compulsory for being eligible for third Professional (Part II) examination.

#### 14 Results

Supplementary examinations shall not be conducted later than 90 days from the date of declaration of the results of the main examination, so that the learners who pass can join the main batch for progression and the remainder would appear for the examination in the subsequent year.

A learner shall not be entitled to graduate later than ten (10) years of her/his joining the first MBBS.

15. To achieve the target of completing the process of university examination including the declaration of results within the one month duration, gaps shall be permitted inter subjects only and no gap between the practical examination will be given.

(Nursing) final year. These are now to be implemented by the MGUMST. The Council resolved that the Dean, Faculty of Nursing should immediately submit his proposal to the Controller of Examinations as per the amendments made by the INC.   - There shall be two examinations of First, Second, Third and Fourth (Final) BPT/BOT course in one academic year, the main examination and subsequent supplementary examination for the failed candidates.
  - A candidate who has completed a regular course of study prescribed for First BPT/BOT for one academic year shall be eligible to appear respectively at First BPT/BOT examination.
  - iii) A candidate failing in any number of subjects at the main examination shall be allowed to appear in the failing subjects at the ensuing supplementary examination.
  - iv) A candidate who has not passed even a single subject (theory & practical) of First, Second or Third BPT/BOT supplementary examination shall not be promoted to respective next higher class.
  - v) A candidate who has passed one or more subject(s) of First BPT/BOT main/supplementary examination will be promoted to Second year course and after completion of regular course of study for one academic year shall be eligible for Second BPT/BOT examination. He/she shall also be permitted to appear in the due papers of First BPT/BOT examination along with Second BPT/BOT examination. The result of First and Second BPT/BOT examinations will be declared.

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- vi) A candidate who has passed one or more subject(s) of Second BPT/BOT main/supplementary examination will be promoted to Third year course and after completion of regular course of study for one academic year shall be eligible for Third BPT/BOT examination. He/she shall also be permitted to appear in the due papers of First and/or Second BPT/BOT examinations along with Third BPT/BOT examination. The result of First, Second and Third BPT/BOT examinations will be declared.
- vii) A candidate who has passed one or more subject(s) of Third BPT/BOT main/supplementary examination will be promoted to the Fourth (Final) year BPT/BOT course and will pursue study for one academic year of Fourth (Final) BPT/BOT course.

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## Minutes of the Twenty Fifth meeting of the Academic Council held on November 22, 2018

Twenty Fifth Meeting of the Academic Council was convened on November 22, 2018 at 1:00 P.M. in the Conference Room of the University under the Chairmanship of Dr. M.C. Misra, President, MGUMST.

List of the members who participated in the meeting is annexed as Annexure-1.

The Chairman at the outset of the meeting welcomed Prof (Dr.) S. C. Tiwari, President, Kidney Health Education Research Foundation; Vice President, Diabetes Foundation and Former Chairman, Dept. of Nephrology, AIIMS, New Delhi for attending the meeting of the Council for the first time. The Chairman also welcomed the esteemed members and Special Invitees attending the meeting and appreciated the contribution made by them to bring about the academic progress of the University. The members of the Academic Council assured the Chairman about their commitment for the academic growth of the University in all spheres.

Then after, the agenda items were taken. Discussions and deliberations took place on each agenda item and following decisions were taken -

- 1. Minutes of Twenty Fourth meeting of the Academic Council held on October 23, 2018 - were confirmed.
- 2. For passing the grace for Degrees before their conferment on the concerned students at the next Convocation, the Registrar, after seeking permission from the Chairman, requested the Deans of the Faculties of Nursing and Physiotherapy to move to the Council to pass a grace for admission of their students to the said Degrees.

Accordingly, the Deans of the Faculties moved to the Council as under

After the supplication by the Deans, Faculty of Nursing and Faculty of Physiotherapy as above, the Chairman requested to the Council - "GRACE BE PASSED" and the Council assenting the Chairman said

#### "THE GRACE IS PASSED"

The Deans, Faculty of Nursing and Faculty of Physiotherapy then presented to the Chairman the lists of candidates of their Faculties to be conferred with respective Degrees (Annexure-2).

3. The Council was updated regarding establishment of Department of Clinical Psychology with M.Sc., M. Phil. and Ph.D. courses in Clinical Psychology at MGMCH

In continuation with earlier presentation held on 26th February 2018 Dr. M. Shamsudeen gave another presentation in this academic Council meeting covering the following topics:

- i) Establishment of Department of Clinical Psychology and starting higher education courses viz. M.Sc., M.Phil. and Ph.D. in Clinical Psychology at
- ii) Starting PG Medical MD in Palliative Medicine at MGMCH and M.Sc. in Palliative Nursing Care at MGNC
- iii) Starting PG Courses (a) MD in Hospital Administration and (b) Masters in Hospital Administration (MHA)
- iv) Starting Certificate course in Para Hospital Sciences (Elderly Care Giver)

The following decisions were made after in depth deliberations at the Academic Council meeting:

- i) Dr. M Shamsudeen will proceed with establishment of Department of Clinical Psychology as early as possible. For getting proper space for OPD and Academic areas, teaching faculties, instruments & equipment, library books etc. he shall seek directions and approval from the Dean & Principal, MGMCH.
- ii) The University shall submit an application to the Government of Rajasthan for seeking permission to start M.Sc. Psychology (two years duration)
- iii) After establishment of the Dept. of Clinical Psychology in MGMCH, Dr. Shamsudeen shall arrange all necessary requirements as per the Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) Regulations and apply to the RCI for starting M.Phil and PhD in Clinical Psychology and submit application to the RCI as per time bound schedule of RCI i.e. before 31st August 2019.
- iv) Dr. M. Shamsudeen will also proceed with establishment of Department of Palliative Medicine with the approval of the Dean & Principal, MGMCH for getting proper space including space for OPD, 30 beds exclusive IPD/ward, academic & admin areas, teaching faculties, etc. and apply first to State Gover of Rajasthan for getting the required No Objection Certificate (NOC)/Essentiality Certificate for further applying to the MCI for starting PG course- MD Palliative Medicine with 4 seats per annum.

- v) It was informed by the Dean & Principal, Nursing College that there is no course like M.Sc. Nursing (Palliative Care) in the list of the courses governed by the Indian Nursing Council. Instead, there is "Nursing Practitioner in Critical Care (NPCC)" course for which he has already applied to the Indian Nursing Council and till date, response of the Indian Nursing Council is awaited.
  - The Academic Council after considering the entire matter resolved that the Dean & Principal, MGNC must pursue the application already submitted in the Indian Nursing Council for NPCC course.
- vi) Regarding starting of PG courses MD in Hospital Administration and Masters in Hospital Administration (MHA) Dr. M Shamsudeen reported that MGMCH already has all the facilities in the Hospital to start these courses.

The Academic Council therefore resolved that Dr. Shamsudeen shall proceed:

- a) to get established full-fledged Department of Hospital Administration with available facilities & administrators and to get recruited required 'teaching faculties for Department of Hospital Administration as per the MCI. He shall then apply to State Govt. of Rajasthan for getting the required Essentiality Certificate for starting MD Hospital Administration with 4 seats per annum.
- to apply to the AICTE to start Masters in Hospital Administration (MHA) course from the ensuing academic year 2019-20 under the affiliation of the MGUMST.
- vii)Regarding Para Hospital Sciences Certificate course (Elderly Care Giver/ Elderly Health Care Provider), the committee already constituted by the Council in its meeting held on February 26, 2018 should submit its recommendations to the President at the earliest and further action be taken accordingly.
- 4. The Principals of Mahatma Gandhi Physiotherapy College & Mahatma Gandhi Occupational Therapy College submitted that they want to amend the syllabuses of Physiotherapy & Occupational Therapy courses. The Council resolved that they must submit complete syllabuses with all proposed amendments well in time in the University office before bringing the same for consideration of the Academic Council. They must also submit the amendments in tabular form stating the existing syllabuses/scheme of examinations and the proposed syllabuses/scheme of examinations with full justification and keeping in view that the syllabuses once finalized should not be changed frequently.

The Meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
